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Summary

Dear Applicant,

Westrec Marinas, Manager of the Chicago Park District's 10 harbors, is pleased to provide you with information pertaining to the availability of a Commercial Jet Ski/PWC Operations in several Chicago Harbors.

Westrec Marinas has identified several harbors and spaces in those harbors that are appropriate for commercial jet ski operations. Jet skis, also known as Personal Watercraft (PWC), are a unique form of boating and have numerous advantages and disadvantages. Due to the nature of the watercraft, there is concern about their operations in many of our harbors. We have identified several locations which minimize their disruption to harbor operations and offer advantages for their operations. We believe locating them on docks which not only have currently available stalls, but also are near the harbor entrances that minimize their impact on other boating customers meets these goals.

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General Conditions

Westrec Marinas has identified several harbors and harbor spaces that are appropriate for commercial jet ski/PWC operations.

- 1. 31st Street J Dock
- 2. Diversey A Dock
- 3. Montrose A Dock
- 4. Alternate locations in the above harbors may be proposed.
- Minimum bid amounts are:
 - o 31st Street K Dock 60-foot stall: \$6000.00 each
 - O Diversey A Dock 30-foot stall: \$3000.00 each
 - o Montrose A Dock 30-foot stall: \$3000.00 each
- Applicant may dock the following number of personal watercrafts per stall:
 - o 31st Street K Dock 60-foot stall: 5
 - Diversey A Dock 30-foot stall: 3
 - Montrose A Dock 30-foot stall: 3
- Payment for 2021 season will be due as follows:
 - One-third due by April 15, 2021
 - One-third due by June 15, 2021
 - o Balance due by August 15, 2021
- Payments for each subsequent season are due as follows:
 - o One-third due by December 15th preceding the season.
 - One-third due by February 15th preceding the season.
 - o Balance due by April 15th preceding the season.
- Commercial activities are allowed from May 1st to October 31st.
- Applicant must comply with all Chicago Park District and harbor rules.
- Applicant must have a Chicago Park District Personal Watercraft Commercial Permit, including any applicable local, state, or federal permits or licenses.
- Application for the Chicago Park District Commercial Permit may be found at https://www.chicagoharbors.info/forms.
- Commercial Permit fee is for each jet ski/personal watercraft and is not included in bid.
- Permit and ownership information required for each personal watercraft to be docked in the assigned Chicago Park District stalls.
- One parking pass included with each stall.
- Stalls may not be utilized for non-permittee boats, for rent or otherwise sub-leased.
- Harbor reserves the right to utilize stalls for transient dockage or other purposes when stall is vacant.
- All spaces are provided in "as-is" condition.
- Awards and/or permits are non-transferable

Selection

The selection process will involve four steps.

- 1. A staff committee will review all submittals and determine submittals to advance to the semi-finals for interviews.
- The Committee may decide to interview the semi-finalists. The interviews will provide an opportunity for the parties to share detailed information about proposed information and the experience of the bidder.
- 3. The staff will review the preliminary proposals and recommend selected bidders to the Chicago Park District.
- 4. If approved by the Chicago Park District, the Chicago Harbors staff will enter into contracts with the selected bidders.

Selection will be based on the revenue to the Chicago Park District, bidder's business plan, experience and any other criteria determined to be applicable by the staff.
