## **HARBOR NOTICE**

# Thank you for joining us this season! The harbor will officially close on October 31, 2024 at 11:59 pm.

ALL BOATS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE HARBOR BY THIS TIME OR THEY WILL BE FINED. LATE LEAVER PERMITS ARE AVAILABLE FOR BURNHAM HARBOR ONLY.

Please ensure that your boat is mechanically ready to depart and planning for any weather conditions are your responsibility and will not be grounds for waiving fines. Electric service will remain on through the end of the season, but water service may be turned off after October 15th due to harbor winterization. You must also remove ALL personal belongings from your mooring, dock and/or your dock box. We are not responsible for ANY items remaining after October 31st. There will be no access to the docks until next season.

Please do not wait until the last minute to remove your belongings or your boat.

#### **LATE LEAVER PERMITS**

Late Leaver Permits will be offered for dockage at Burnham Harbor.

You can apply for your 2024 Late Leaver Permit online at www.chicagoharbors.info/lateleaver, beginning October 1, 2024. Applications must be submitted by October 31st, as no late requests will be accepted.

#### PARKING CARD AND BOAT DECAL STICKER REMINDER

Please keep your 2024 parking cards (excluding Monroe Harbor). If you do not keep your card or lose it, there will be a replacement fee and new passes will not be available until the harbor offices open in May.

Monroe Harbor parking passes must be returned to the Monroe Harbor or Lakeside Garage office by October 31st, or you will need to pay a lost card fee.

PLEASE do not remove your harbor decal sticker from your boat.

We will be using the same harbor decal next season.

### **PARKING ACCESS**

Parking passes are valid for the harbor season only. All harbor lots are officially closed November 1st to April 15th and parking cards will be deactivated for some lots. Access to some lots may be provided but is not guaranteed, particularly for special events. Please contact your harbor office or the Chicago Harbors office if you have any questions.
